Pacific Ocean Triathlon in Iwaki

The 1st ever Pacific Ocean Triathlon is going to be held at Onahama Port on 14 July. This will be the first triathlon held in 8 years as the last one was cancelled due to the effects of the Great East Japan Earthquake. You can either compete or watch the triathlon and help support Iwaki's revitalisation.

For Spectators

Time and Date: Sunday, 14th July, Triathlon starts at 8:45am

Venue: Aquamarine Fukushima and surrounds

For Competitors

You must attend a player's registration and briefing of the event from 3pm-5:30pm on Saturday, 13 July (the day before the triathlon). Registration also takes place from 6am-7:45am on the event day.

Entry Fee: ¥23,000

Course: 1.5km Swim, 40km Cycling, 10km Run = Total 51.5km

Time Limits: 4hrs (60mins for Swimming, 2.5hrs from start for Cycling and 4hrs from start for Run)

Criteria for Competing in Triathlon:

- Be aged 18 years or older
- Be fit and healthy
- Be able to complete a 1.5km swim in open waters
- Be able to tread water for 10 minutes
- Be able to float on your back in water
